2021 Sailing Season

It has been a somewhat tough winter with Covid-19 restrictions and related economic, health, and mobility difficulties. However, the colder winter resulted in thick 6" lake ice strong enough for ice fishing, walking, skating and snowmobiles, but the crusty snow was generally too thick for ice boat sailing. When the thick ice broke-up in early March during strong winds some ice blocks were pushed into docks causing some damage.

So we are looking forward to enjoying another warm peaceful summer at beautiful Red Cedar Lake with our friends and neighbors along with fishing, boating, hiking, kayaking, water skiing, sailing, etc. (Following Covid-19 health guidelines as applicable.)

Sailing has been a popular activity on Red Cedar since the early days. It is a great lake for small boat sailing and learning to sail. The Sunday morning races this summer will start at 11AM June 27th and continue weekly thru September 5th. All lake residents and friends are welcome to participate. A youth class was started to encourage young sailors.

On Saturday morning June 19th there will be a very informal orientation at 152 Lakeside for those unfamiliar with the races and boats. If you don't have a boat, there will be some available that day and also sailing instruction. After the Sunday morning races there is a short gathering for refreshments and ribbons, almost everyone earns a ribbon. The after race gatherings are also great for keeping up with lake news.
