She thanked Lynn Gonzalez for sending emails to members.</p> <p>J. Wislocki discussed the beavers on our lake. There are 2 lodges and if you wish to protect certain trees on your property you need to wrap them in wire.</p>	
Treasurer	<p>R. Macklin presented the budget as of today. Checking -\$1211, Savings -\$45,883 and CD -\$18,085.</p> <p>Three members have not paid the 2018 annual dues and 1 member needs to send in the \$45 late fee.</p>	
Beaches	<p>P. Van Steeden reported that he and his sons installed dock and buoys at both beaches. He asked that members and guests not rock the swim dock which causes damage to the anchor system. He reminded members that dogs are not allowed on beaches. He asked that canoes and kayaks be placed on the racks and not left on the ground.</p>	
Water Quality	<p>M. Fitton announced weed treatment will occur on June 25th for milfoil and lily pads. M. Fitton discussed ways to keep the lake waters clean and healthy especially avoiding lawn fertilizers which feed weeds and promote algae growth. Also regular cleaning of septic systems.</p>	<p>M. Fitton will post signs for weed and lily pad treatment.</p>
Old Business	<p>Honey Ragaglia talked about the Revaluation and the tax committee. She advised members to meet with Vision Appraisals after they receive their new assessment which should be mailed in November.</p>
